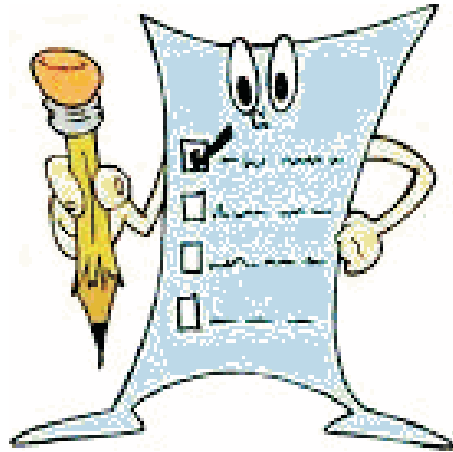
White Hill Concert Date ***Correction***
